# CAVALCADES

## At BTR

So you hiked the Scout Ranch, and all you saw was your own boots?

Come see BTR from the back of horse!

Let HIM watch HIS feet while you enjoy the scenery!

Two- or three-day horseback treks called cavalcades take off on select dates in the fall for the roughest and prettiest parts of the Scout Ranch. Participants get plenty of quality saddle time during the day and sleep “under the stars” at night.



Boy Scout and Venture Crew units with members new to riding, can participate in a full day of horsemanship training for **ONLY** \$40/rider. All of the requirements for the Horsemanship Merit Badge will be covered, and eligible Scouts will have the opportunity to earn that badge in one day!

Minimum age for Cavalcade program is 13 years old, and all riders must weigh less than 250 pounds. Everyone that rides must be currently registered in Scouting, bring a current Type 3 BSA medical form, and be in good physical condition. All participants should have prior horseback experience equal to the BSA Horsemanship Merit Badge. ALL RIDERS will be tested for adequate “horse sense,” after rigorous safety training, before the cavalcade hits the trail.
