Adult in charge: Make sure Everyone coming to BTSR agrees to the following rules:

1. No fireworks, firearms, or firewater permitted. **DO NOT BRING PETS**. Tent camping only: **no RV's**.
2. Two-deep adult leadership required at all times. Co-ed units must have at least on adult (21 yrs+) female.
3. No one may ride in an open vehicle or trailer. **Watch for livestock on ranch road**. Use seatbelts always.
4. **DON'T THROW ROCKS!** Please stay on trails, stay off Forbidden Mountain, stay out of open buildings.
5. Be careful with fire. Ground fires allowed in metal rings only, weather permitting. Report wildfires to ranger.
6. **Advance** written permission from Scout Executive required for all bouldering, rock climbing, or repelling.
7. **HIKERS:** Before you leave, give ranger written itinerary with planned times, trails, and overnight stops. Use the buddy system (Minimum 2 pair) carry extra water, & first aid kit. Do not approach livestock. **DO NOT CROSS BTSR BOUNDARIES AS MARKED ON CAMP MAP WITHOUT ADVANCE WRITTEN PERMISSION FROM RANGER.** Groups permitted to hike south of Blue Hole must be accompanied by approved guide at all times. Call Scout ranch in advance to secure approval & guide.
8. Camp is quiet between 10 pm & 7 am, silent form 11 pm to 6 am. Put all fires dead out by 11 pm.
9. Leave campsite cleaner than you found it. Clean restrooms and all buildings used. Report any damages.
10. Check out with ranger and pay all fees owed before leaving BTSR.

Report anything that should not be happening on YOUR Boy Scout Camp to ranger immediately.
