WE AGREE TO THE FOLLOWING RULES FOR USE OF THE BASE

1. Check in and out with the Harbormaster. Present this application upon arrival. Do **NOT** set up camp before talking to the Harbormaster. Campsites are assigned to units. If for some reason the trip is cancelled, please call the Harbormaster at (915) 728-8887.
2. Leadership **MUST** arrive with unit.
3. Lake regulations **MUST** be followed:
 - A. Swimming and Waterskiing – Check with Harbormaster.
 - B. **LIFE JACKETS MUST BE WORN BY EVERYONE USING WATERCRAFT.**
 - C. Adult(s) **MUST** observe and supervise **YOUTH** in the water.
 - D. All state Game and Fishing laws **MUST** be observed.
4. Base rowboats and canoes must be shared with other Scout campers.
5. Units desiring to use power boats and/or sailboats should bring their own. Outboard motors may not be used on base row boats or canoes.
6. R.V. sites with electricity are \$10.00/per vehicle/day or any portion of a day (8a.m. to 8p.m.)
 R.V. sites should be reserved prior to camp use.
7. No building to be used unless reserved in advance and **ALL** fees paid.
 - A. Building fee \$30.00 a day or part of a day (8a.m. to 8p.m.)
 - B. Kitchen fee \$30.00 a day or part of a day (8a.m. to 8p.m.)
 - C. All garbage must be disposed of in the dumpster provided.
8. This is a multi-use camp; the unit must be prepared to share the use of the facility with other groups.
9. Do not trespass on the property or docks of the base neighbors. (**VERY IMPORTANT**)
10. The following are **NOT PERMITTED:** Pets, Firearms, Fireworks, Alcoholic Beverages and Illegal Drugs.
11. **NO** individuals may ride in beds of pickups on Scouting property at anytime.
12. Units will be responsible for any damage to the facilities or equipment.
13. **ALL FIRES MUST BE BUILT IN FIRE BOXES OR PROVIDED EQUIPMENT ONLY!**
14. All local, state, federal, and BSA rules, laws and/or policy apply.
